Welcome to Our Salem Rotary Foundation Annual Report

The Salem Rotary Foundation (SRF) board of directors is delighted to present the 2023-24 annual report. This report summarizes your contributions to the foundation's assets, investments/expenditures in our local community and specific projects worldwide. If you are a member of the Rotary Club of Salem, you are also a member of SRF.

SRF serves as the charitable heart of the Rotary Club of Salem, providing financial oversight to the club's philanthropic activities. The Rotary Club of Salem focuses its efforts on membership, fellowship, and general community involvement and makes all charitable grant and funding decisions.

SRF supports Club Good Works activities such as exchange students, international projects, literacy grants, Rotary International support, Tree of Joy, and Shelter Box. Additionally, the foundation supports large and small grant programs funded by the generosity of Rotarians and other community members.

Since its inception in 1969, SRF has maintained a bank account at Pioneer Trust Bank. The growth of the Foundation's assets led to establishing an investment account through the trust department at Pioneer Trust Bank. Annual filings with the IRS, the Oregon Department of Justice, and the Charitable Division are completed to maintain our nonprofit status.

Additionally, funds remain from the construction of the Gerry Frank Amphitheatre. SRF has invested those funds and continues to hold them in anticipation of using them appropriately for Amphitheatre improvements in the future.

SRF holds assets for three purposes:

- Foundation: current donations and invested funds used to support Good Works efforts at a 5% rate determined as a rolling average over a four-year average balance of Foundation assets.
- Good Works: current donations and Foundation support used to fund charitable activities and grant awards
- Amphitheatre: invested funds earmarked for Amphitheatre improvements

Remember, SRF's monthly and annual financial reports are readily available to all members. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask.

We should all take pride in this work, which reflects our collective efforts. The annual report serves as a testament to our significant impact together!

Treasurer's Report

The year just completed was an excellent one for our foundation. We incorporated all the Rotary Club of Salem's charitable activity into the foundation and produced excellent results with our fundraising, investing activity, and expense management. For the core foundation our \$201,587 net increase was our second best ever.

The Club Good Works (CGW) Account started the year at \$83,821. The annual fundraiser netted \$96,045, and \$63,500 in foundation grant funds were transferred into the CGW account. Our major grant of \$75,000 went to the Boys and Girls Club for kitchen upgrades, \$20,000 went to seven small grants, \$3,000 for the Duval Scholarship at Chemeketa, \$15,250 in Literacy Committee Grants, \$15,800 World Community Service, and smaller amounts for RYLA, Exchange Students, Tree of Joy and other charitable activities. See the Statement of Activity Report for details. The Club Good Works account grew by \$866 for the year.

The Salem Rotary Foundation (SRF) had donations of \$70,108, bellringers at \$14,012, Raffle Receipts at \$1,914, investment results at \$164,327 (a 13.95% return on invested funds), some smaller income and expense items and finished the year \$201,587 to the good, after funding \$63,500 in grants. See the Statement of Activity Report for details. Our goals for the year were \$50,000 in donations, \$14,000 bellringers, \$2,000 raffle, and \$105,917 (8%) investment results. As previously stated, it was an excellent year.

Our foundation also has funds specifically raised for and dedicated to the Gerry Frank | Salem Rotary Amphitheater in Riverfront Park. We started the year at \$286,368 and ended the year at \$320,945, an increase of \$34,577 or 12%. We did not spend any of this money.

Adding all of this up, we started the year at \$1,705,753 and ended the year at \$1,942,781, up \$237,029 or 13.9%.

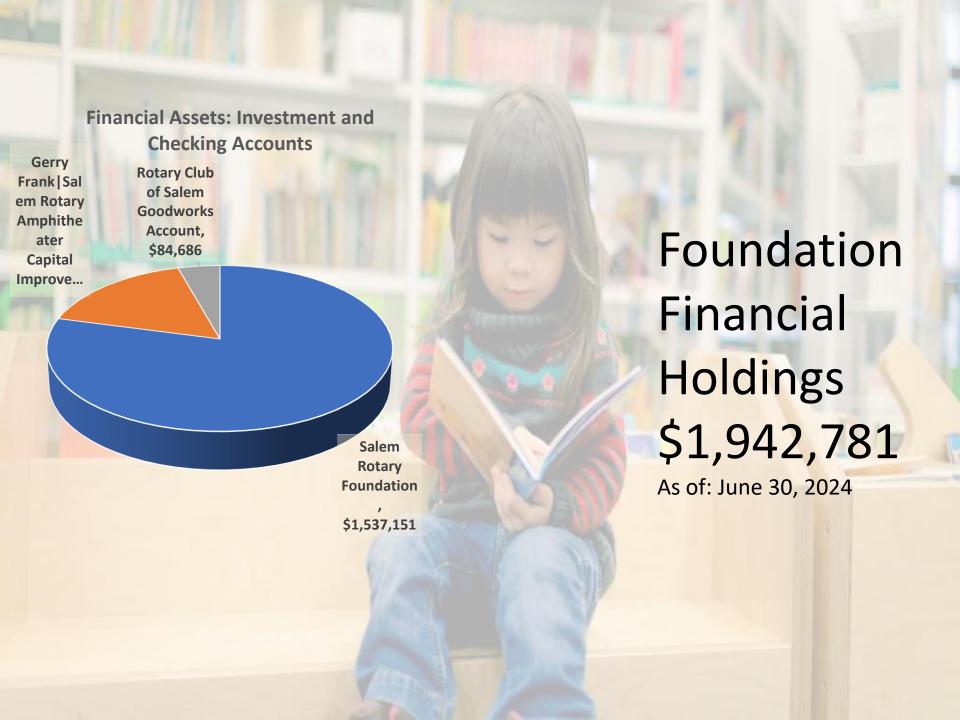
